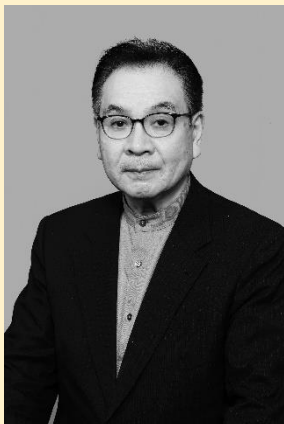
演多数。各省庁の移民政策関連の有識者会議で委員を務めている。
